As we spring into a new season, have a look at some of the fantastic learning that has been going on in school over the past 2 weeks.



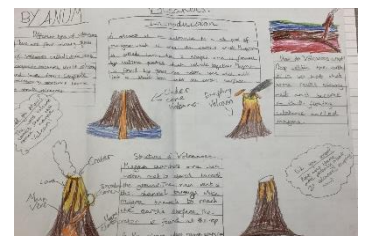

For homework, pupils in Goldsworthy class have been busy making these wonderful 3D models of a Church. This is to reinforce the materials work they have completed in DT and their learning about places of worship in RE.
