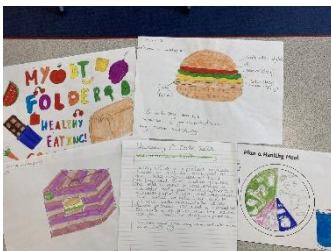

Dear parents and carers,

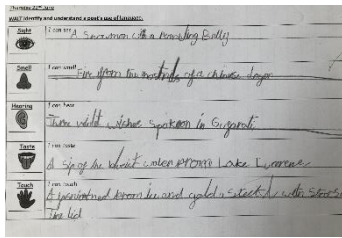


This week we were visited by Sarah from SCARF. Life Education & SCARF is the UK's leading charity provider of Personal, Social, Health, Relationships, Economic (PSHRE) and wellbeing education in primary schools and is the [PSHRE programme](#) that we follow in school. Sarah visited each class to deliver sessions relating to our bodies and how to keep healthy and safe. She also brought along a firm favourite - Harold the giraffe.

Picasso class have been learning about the rainforest with a focus on a different layer each week. They have also undertaken some independent research on the animals that live in each layer – here are some wonderful pictures of animals in the emergent and canopy layer.



This term's DT project in Klimt class is to design a sandwich that fulfils the criteria of a balanced diet. This week the children have been designing the packaging for their sandwich. I'm looking forward to seeing (and tasting) their final products in a few weeks' time.



Goldsworthy class have been learning the poem 'The Magic Box' by Kit Wright. They have spent this week exploring and understanding the poet's use of language, ready to create their own poems next week. 'My favourite line is *a sip of the bluest water from Lake Lucerene*,' said Reegan.

Banksy class have been learning about different Jewish Festivals as part of their RE unit. Alongside this, they have been creating and sampling some traditional Jewish foods.

Reminders
